

Founders' Cup Coach Worksheet

- I am prepared to have my roster information and Founders' Cup Fee to be in the CYSA office, prior to 5:00 PM, on November 1, 2011. I am aware that this must be in the hands of the staff, before close of business, and may not be dropped into a mail slot, or post-marked for this day.
- I have informed all of the parents & players that no dogs may be brought to Founders' Cup. I have made them aware that if they bring a dog, they will be asked to leave the fields. I have pointed out to them that if it is a warm day, they make not be able to just take an animal to a vehicle and place them inside. In regards to the animal, if they are staying in the team hotel, they need to be aware that the hotel may not allow animals in rooms.
- For the team hotel, I have checked to see if washing machines are available for uniforms. In wet weather, uniforms will get muddy, requiring the need to wash them prior to the next days' play. The team has discussed as to whom might be on 'washing duty', and as to how the uniforms would be collected and redistributed.
- I have researched venue location/driving instructions and have distributed such information, in writing, to all team members, to insure that everyone has directions to the facility.
- The team has spoken about players whose parents may not be able to attend, but they will let the player attend. I have discussed with any such parent as to whom they would have the player ride/stay with. I informed the parent that they would have to speak with the team parent, for whom they wanted their player to be with. I informed the parent to insure that any medications, or medical issues have been passed on to the party taking responsibility for the player attending the Cup.
- If the team is spending the night, I have spoken with parents about expected conduct at the hotel/motel.
- I have checked my schedule to see if my team will be playing on turf fields where metal cleats are not allowed. I have ensured that all of my players are aware of the no metal cleats rule, for any field that we might play on.
